Our first Proficiency Day in September was a great success with 90 members renewing their awards. The next Proficiency day will be held on Sunday 11 October commencing at 8am with the pool swims being held at Pizze Park pool at 7am. Everyone must renew their Bronze Medallion and other awards every season to ensure that you can continue to carry out patrolling duties or to compete at carnivals.

**Christmas Day** - On Christmas Day we are looking for volunteers to help out on patrols. If you can spare a few hours could you please send the office an email stating what time you would be available. As everyone knows, this is a very busy day on the beach with lots of tourists and locals enjoying the beautiful weather and the children christening their new presents in the surf. To make it easier, we need as many patrolling members as possible to volunteer so that everyone shares the responsibility around. This is also an excellent way to pick up lost points as volunteering on Christmas Day you can earn between 25 and 45 points, depending on the time of day that you patrol. What to bring:

- Your timed pool swim (no swim, no proficiency - it's a pre-requisite)
- Your patrol cap or competition cap and swimmers
- Completed proficiency paperwork

## Pool swim information

Pool swims will be held prior to the Proficiency at Pizzey Park pool or you can pick up a form from the office and have a Level 1 swim coach sign you off.

**PLEASE NOTE: Any member who did their BM or previous proficiency prior to 30 June this year must do their proficiency to continue to do patrols or compete.**



## RULES FOR BORROWING CLUB EQUIPMENT

Anyone who wants to use/borrow Club equipment must first obtain permission for the appropriate Club Officer before any gear or equipment leaves the Surf Club premises.

Once permission is obtained, there is an Equipment Register in the office. Please go to the office and register your name and the type of equipment you are borrowing and once it is returned, sign it back into the Register. This will ensure that everyone knows where Club equipment is at all times.
